

Safety protocols for candidates for examination during COVID-19 pandemic

1. Each candidate should bring their own Face masks, gloves and drinking water bottle for the exam
2. Candidate should report to the College one hour before the Examination (at **9 am** for the Morning Examinations and at **1 pm** for the Afternoon Examinations of Sept 2020)
3. Candidates also have to strictly follow guidelines on social distancing as well as use sanitizers.
4. Body temperatures of candidates will be checked with thermo guns before entering the examination hall.
5. Candidates would also have to observe social distancing by maintain a distance of at least 6 feet from each other while entering the exam hall and also while in the Campus.
6. Candidates are required to sanitise their hands with soap before entering the exam hall.
7. After **completing the check for temperature** and using the **sanitiser** at the entrance, the candidate has **to proceed to the Examination Hall** and **not loiter in the Halls** and should **not stand in groups**. After the Examination, the candidate on leaving the Examination Hall should not stand in groups in the Campus.
8. Candidates showing COVID symptoms (body temperature above 99.4 degrees) will have to appear for the exam in separate rooms.
9. The Candidate has to bring his own stationery as no exchange of stationery will be allowed in the Examination Hall, keeping in mind COVID protocol.
10. The candidate would be denied entry to the examination hall if they violate the COVID protocols.
