**COVID GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING THEORY/PRACTICAL
CLASSES**

- Daily symptom screening upon entry for staff and students – do not allow anyone with a fever above 99.4 F (37.6C) or with signs of illness to enter.
- Hand washing with soap and water. Cleaning with alcohol-based hand rub/Sanitiser
- All students have to wear a Face Mask. Face shields can also be worn.
- students are to observe social distancing (6 ft / 2-meter distance.)
- Students should maintain a staggered distance during the demonstration time/Theory classes at the lab/classroom.
- Students are to strictly to stay in same place where they are assigned, in the Labs/Classrooms and maintain social distancing at all times.
- hand hygiene Compulsory upon entry and exit of the lab.
- Avoid sharing tool kit, or other learning aids.
- Belongings including Bags/Mobiles are not allowed in the Labs.
- Students should not enter any area in a group and always maintain social distance, this includes wash rooms, classrooms etc.
- Students have to bring their Tiffin/water bottles as they will not be allowed to leave the campus until the end of the day whenever they have offline classes in the College.
- Cover coughs and sneezes using an elbow or a tissue. Dispose of the tissue and clean hands immediately
- ***Advice to students:*** Stay home when sick, or after close contact with someone who is sick (**inform Mentor-if not well for more than a day, get a Medical Certificate showing cause of illness**)
